Sound Healing: from Pseudo-Science to Medical Science
(or My Strife for Rife)

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The use of vibration is a powerful tool that not only affects the energy, emotions, & spirit of matter, but matter itself; this is not pseudo-science (as some medias would have you believe) but a documented phenomena that connects sound to colour, to frequency, to every living cell (or parasite for example). The science behind using specific vibrations to resonate small organisms – such as cells, bacteria, & viruses – is documented starting in the 1930's by Royal Raymond Rife. The validity behind Rife's research and life (including his wikipedia article) has come greatly into question by many medical science groups, who have made it difficult for the general public to find concrete information on Rife's life. For controversial reasons Sound Therapy is not concrete medical treatment. Where is the science behind matching frequencies to colour, to living objects? The general public may believe that Sound Therapy has simply not advanced that far in science, while chemical-radiation has been greatly studied & applied for in cancer treatment. It seems a bit backwards to think that less research would be done on an easily producible therapy, such as sound therapy, than a difficult & expensive therapy, such as chemo-therapy.

There are many claims on the internet that Royal Rife was the victim of a conspiracy to cover-up his research in order to maintain the agendas of certain businessmen. On the other hand, many businessmen are currently profiting from selling "Rife Machines" & other forms of frequency therapy (the Rife Machine at rifiedigital.com sells for about \$500) but prices vary greatly. The perfect blend of argument for, and against Rife's research leads to a compelling trip down the conspiracy rabbit hole. Only a cunning intellect could discern what's fact and what's not, maybe.

So who was Royal Raymond Rife? I took most of his biography off an old wikipedia biography from 2007 (<http://unusualscience.com/Rife-July-07-Wikipedia.htm>), which has been dramatically changed in his current wikipedia article.

Royal Rife (1888-1971) was born in Nebraska, where he entered medicine. Rife then claimed that he diverted his studies to bacteriology with Karl Zeiss in New York. Rife then moved to Heidelberg, Germany where he developed photomicrographs for the Atlas of Parasites for the University of Heidelberg (he was later given an honorary doctorate in Parasitology for this in 1914). By 1914 Rife had already moved back to the USA and married, and was living in San Diego, California, working as a chauffeur for the wife of Henry Timkin, a rich relative. After Rife saved Timkin's wife from death by discovering the cause of her illness: invisible mould growing on their food, Timkin began funding Rife's research.

With his newfound funds Rife built the Universal Rife Microscope, building the first in 1933. The device involved using prisms, facing each other, spinning in opposite directions; along with many other complex and perhaps unorthodox devices. According to Rife's research notes the Universal Microscopes (he built 5 overall) allowed Rife to see up to x20,000, or even x50,000 resolution. This allowed Rife to view viruses, bacteria, cells etc in motion. Rife, along with a number of the worlds leading research doctors at the time such as E.C. Rosenow & Karl Friedrich Meyer studied a number of different viruses including Polio and Typhoid. The unique reported feature of Rife's microscope was that it not only magnified far better than the microscopes of the time, but it also surrounded the objects being magnified by a unique colour that was always specific to that type of organism (cancer cells were

reported to always be a purplish-red and typhoid was always a turquoise-blue). These consistent colours were simply representations of consistent frequencies, and therefore could then be translated into lower, base fundamentals of those colour frequencies, which were audible sounds.

According to his colleagues, Rife would spend hours with a frequency generator, directing the sound at the organism he was observing on the microscope. He would start at the frequency that he calculated related to the colour the organism was emitting, then slowly move the dial micrometers up and down until he observed that the colour would suddenly dissipate around the organism. According to modern wikipedia: "Rife claimed to have documented a 'Mortal Oscillatory Rate' for various pathogenic organisms, and to be able to destroy the organisms by vibrating them at this particular rate."

This discovery of the 'Mortal Oscillatory Rates' by Rife was the very beginning of the **Consolidated-Annotated-Frequencies-List (CAFL)**. The premise of the CAFL is the science of the vibration of everything. Because these frequencies are geared towards an organism's "mortal" vibration, the list is only geared towards unwanted ailments, such as cough&cold, constipation, or stiff muscles right to the more extreme ailments of pneumonia, AIDS, or even cancer.

To penetrate & vibrate unwanted organisms in the body, Rife invented the "Beam Ray", which entered clinical trials in 1934. It emitted the assigned frequency of an organism that would vibrate it from the inside out. Many of the same organisms were observed to gyrate to the point of destroying their cell walls, which would cause the organisms to then turn themselves inside out; if cells did not immediately react to their oscillating frequency, they would often stop functioning well soon after the treatment. This discovery led to research that documented curing polio, typhoid and even cancer by systematically destroying the unwanted organisms at their specific frequency, while leaving the healthy cells around it unharmed. Again, from Wikipedia: a "typical 'Rife device' consisted of a [nine-volt battery](#), wiring, a switch, a timer and two short lengths of copper tubing, which delivered an "almost undetectable" current unlikely to penetrate the skin."

In 1937, Royal Rife, and a number of his colleagues, took 16 terminally ill patients from Pasadena County Hospital to conduct research on Rife's Beam Ray. All of the patients had been deemed "terminally ill" by Pasadena Hospital and were expected to die from their illness within a month or two. It was reported that all the patients suffered from terminal stages of cancer while other reports claim some patients may have also had tuberculosis, polio, or typhoid. Over the period of the study, 14 of the patients had been cured of their illness, and the remaining 2 patients were reported to have had their ailments cured some months after the study had finished.

With such a successful study it would seem natural for Rife to take his Universal microscope, Frequency Lists of Parasites, and Beam Ray to the public. Dr. Johnson was a practicing doctor experimenting with the Rife's Frequencies and Beam Ray.

"According to the *San Diego Evening Tribune* in 1938, Rife stopped short of claiming that he could cure cancer, but did argue that he could; devitalize disease organisms; in living tissue, 'with certain exceptions'" - wikipedia 2007

After successfully curing a terminally ill patient, Morris Fishbein (editor of the *Journal of the American Medical Association*) met the cured man, and alerted the AMA. It was then reported that the AMA then sent a letter to Dr. Johnson, asking to purchase the rights to the Beam Ray for a handsome fee. After Dr. Johnson had refused the AMA had then paid lawyers to legally discredit Rife's Beam Ray.

The court case against Rife apparently drove him to drinking, and left him penniless. Even though he won the court case overall, he didn't have enough money to continue his

business and research, and his drinking problems continued. The AMA demanded all American Doctors to revoke their Beam Ray machines and discontinue their use indefinitely. All doctors did save Dr. Milbank Johnson & Dr. James Couche.

Despite Rife's hardships the CAFL remained, along with a few of Rife's microscope's and Beam Rays. In 1953, the Allied Research Laboratory, who employed Rife, conducted a study using Rife's microscope to aid in curing cancer & tuberculosis. In 1974 Dr. Crane was approached by John Bedini regarding his "Universal Virus Microscope", the tests resulted in numerous studies which cured terminally ill patients. The studies resulted in a book published in the 80's called "The Cancer Cure that Worked".

Another major contributor to the Science of Pathogens and the 'Mortal Oscillating Rate' was Hulda Clark. Her book "The Cure for All Diseases" discusses her experiments using an 'audio oscillator' to find common resonance between a patient and a pathogen in one of her samples. If a pathogen was found to have oscillation with a patient that indicated that the pathogen was inside the patient's body. Clark would then use her "Zapper" to vibrate the pathogen from the inside out. Though her technology was far behind that of Rife's she also wrote a lot on diet and environment for good health as well. She believed that disease was only caused by two things: pathogens, or pollutants.

Today Rife's research can be seen in many businesses that sell Rife Machines or Rife related machines such as Hulda Clark's Syncrometer & Zapper, & the Doug Coil Machine. These options have had the most success with those suffering from Lyme disease, there are a number of youtube channels and blogs by those who are using these machines to successfully cure their Lyme disease.

However, today there are only 2 Rife Microscopes in existence, one is privately owned. The technology that connected to Rife's original research is shaky at best. You may notice that some frequencies on the CAFL are higher than 20,000 Hz, which is inaudible. So how could Rife have found those frequencies by "tuning it to the colour"? He couldn't have, so you may note that Rife's original frequencies must be within audible range (20-20,000Hz), any other frequencies have been added by other researchers. It's also worth noting that Rife would often round off his notes, so the exact frequency got more questionable the higher the frequency got.

It's an unfortunate reality: Rife was not a perfectionist (most aren't) and the veils of confusion over the many years since 1933 have practically made this science a pseudo-science again. Two new hopes come with our modern microscopes, which have greatly improved and become affordable to the masses. This is allowing hobby researchers to be able to research the frequencies of the CAFL, using simply an at home microscope to document it, (then post it on youtube). It is likely that the internet will be our best tool to share in the research of the CAFL, until the use of sound therapy is re-introduced to the mainstream medical system.

The public is beginning to share in the truth that sound is not just for healing but can also be used to systematically destroy unwanted organisms. This just goes to show how varied sound healing really is, from healing the soul & the mind, to purifying the body. With further documented research, sound can become an idea interwoven with medicine, for the health & happiness of humanity (not our bank statements).
