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## Ancient Egyptian Wielders of Vibration

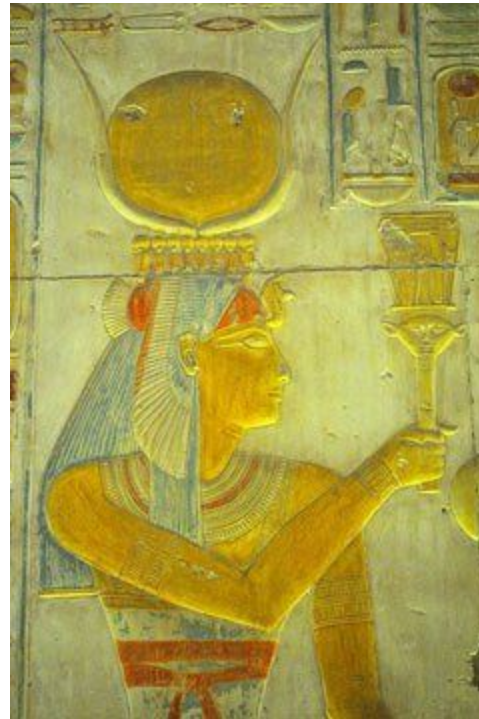
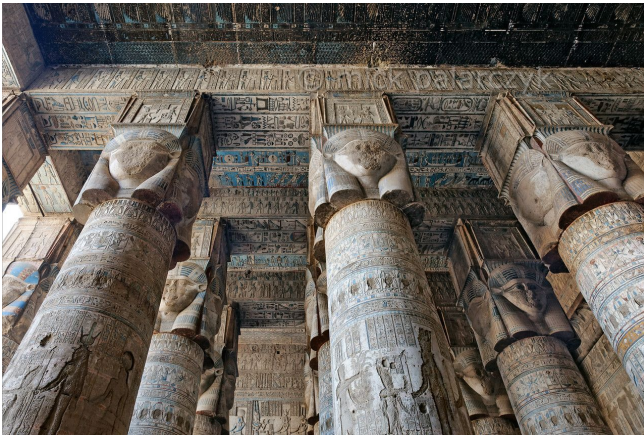
Within the world of those consciously experiencing their own expansion, ancient civilizations are often looked to for guidance on how to best navigate. Of these ancient civilizations, ancient Egypt is revered for its sophistication on many levels. Architecture, art, science, and math are a few commonly noted by scholars around the globe. In sound healing class, the topic of ancient Egypt naturally arose as sound played a huge role in the intricacies of the civilization. However, it was not much expanded on, and therefore tugged at my curiosity. I began to wonder about those hieroglyphs and their depictions of gods and goddesses in ceremony. What was the story? What role did vibration play in that? My curiosity led me to honing in and focusing on highlighting a few specific gods and goddesses of ancient Egypt that served as gatekeepers and wielders of sacred sound.

Let's talk about Hathor, the goddess of music and transformation. She's also known as the goddess of fertility, sexual ecstasy, abundance, and bliss. Looking at the shape of Hathor's face, you can see a strong resemblance to the life giving reproductive system of the human female body. Her womb-shaped face is framed by two cow-like ears, symbolizing her connection to sound. Hathor was worshipped at Denderah, a temple located on the west bank of the Nile. The temple faces the rising of the star Sirius, which the Hathors, a group of interdimensional beings who were connected to ancient Egypt through the Temples of the Goddess Hathor, deem to be a portal into our universe. The temple was found housing many musical instruments including harps, lyres, flutes and drums.

Hathor taught healing through the arts of sacred music and dance. The main musical instrument she is associated with is the sistrum. The bells on each of the four bars of the sistrum were said to be tuned to the specific vibrations of the four elements. Playing the

sistrum honored and symbolized Hathor's generative powers as well as her harmonizing and balancing energy. The sistrun was also used as tool to facilitate ascension. The vibrations it creates assisted initiates in facilitating the rising up of kundalini energies within their bodies. Sistrums produce and give off ultrasonic waveforms. These ultrasonic waves, beyond the normal hearing range of humans, was of benefit for expansion and ascension.



Hathor main lessons surround the teaching that sound is the basis of creation. She views humans as standing waves of vibration. She also sees humans as a complex series of harmonics. She can see the human aura emitting sounds that represent the wavelengths of our organs. When blockages occur, she can see it and produce frequencies that clear the blockage. If you're dealing with blockages, especially those connected to reproduction, self-expression, abundance, and joy, Hathor may be the perfect goddess to call upon for help.

Now, I'd like to transition to another powerful ancient egyption god in the world of sound, Tehuti. Also widely known as Thoth, he is the eldest son of Ra. His other names include Djehuty, Tahuti, Sheps, Lord of Khemenu, Khenti, Mehi, and Hermes. He is depicted with a human body and the head of an ibis bird. There is much speculation surrounding the symbology of the ibis bird and why it was chosen as his worldly representation. Some say it is because the ibis bird was found along the Nile near the papyrus plants. It

is also suggested that the ibis is symbolic of wisdom, the moon, and magic, all of which Tehuti holds some kind of connection to or mastery of. Another source says that “Thoth” is the sound the ibis bird makes during digestion. There are many a mystery surrounding the imagery representing Tehuti, but nonetheless, his place as a high priest in this world stands strong.

Tehuti holds many titles. He is god wisdom, writing and scribes, communication, hieroglyphs, architecture, mathematics, physics, accounting, astronomy, science, magic, self-mastery, and recorder at the “weighing of the heart” ceremony. This is just a brief list of the titles he claims. We can gauge from the numerous subjects of expertise the level of powerful energy this god holds.



It is said that he hatched the world egg with the power of his voice. In many different creation stories from around the world, the egg symbolizes the infinite creative power from which the world would be birthed. In the Egyptian creation story it is said that using the power of his voice alone, he hatched the egg that then birth all of creation. He is also known to be self-created, existing since the beginning of well... existence.

Very popular are his Emerald tablets, said to be written during his incarnation as an Atlantean priest. They were discovered by M.Doreal in the pyramids of South America. Upon Thoth’s initiation into the mysteries of creation by his father Thothme, he received the key to immortality. It is said that when Atlantis sank, he and his followers migrated to Egypt and founded what we know as the ancient Egyptian civilization. The Emerald Tablets tell us the story of Atlantis. In it, he describes the prestige of the the civilization, as well as how it ended up sinking. He goes on to describe the journey to and within Egypt, even describing the construction of the Great Pyramid.

Most importantly, The Emerald Tablets talk about the interconnectedness of everything in the universe.
